The Regulations of the Competition

- 1. The Competition organisers are as follows:
 - The Henryk Karliński Legnica Culture Centre,
 - The Lutheran Parish in Legnica,
 - The Fryderyk Chopin University of Music (Church Music Speciality),
 - The Grażyna and Kiejstut Bacewicz Academy of Music in Łódź (Organ and Church Music Faculty).
- 2. The subject of the competition is the original composition for the organ solo.
- 3. The compositions should relate to the feast of 500th anniversary of Reformation and should be intended for the Virgin Mary Church in Legnica organ (two manuals with a pedal key, please see the enclosed disposal).
- 4. The Competition is open to composers of all nationalities who will not have been more than 35 years old by the end of the year 2017 and for all students of music, regardless of age.
- 5. Each participant may submit up to three compositions of their own authorship.
- 6. The duration of the piece must not go over 10 minutes.
- 7. The submitted piece must be original composition which has not been performed, published in any form or awarded in any other composers' competition before.
- 8. The composition should be submitted in the form of complete score with an emblem, three copies of A4 format. A sealed envelope marked with the same emblem should be enclosed. The envelope must include author signed copy of their identity card and the following details: full name, address, e-mail address, phone number, short biographical profile and the proof of payment of the competition fee in amount of 20EURO (or PLN equivalent) per each submitted piece, paid to the Organiser's bank account: Legnickie Centrum Kultury im.H.Karlińskiego: 91 1090 2066 0000 0005 4200 0402 with the additional note "MKK LCO 2017".
- 9. It is acceptable to enclose also a CD containing a computer recording of the complete piece.
- 10. The scores need to be sent to:
 - Legnickie Centrum Kultury im. H. Karlińskiego,

- ul. Chojnowska 2, 59-220 Legnica, Poland, with additional note "MKK LCO 2017" no later than by **June 20, 2017** (postmark date).
- 11. The works submitted will not be returned.
- 12. Scores which are illegible or do not meet the requirements specified above will not be qualified for the Competition.
- 13. The works submitted will be assessed by the Jury of a well-known authorities in the areas of composition, organ performance and improvisation.
- 14. The Jury will award I, II and III prize and distinctions.
- 15. The Jury reserves the right not to award I prize or distinction.
- 16. The winning pieces will be performed during 31st Legnica Organ Conversatory at Virgin Mary Lutheran Church in Legnica in September 2017. They will be recorded and then published.
- 17. The Jury working session and the announcement of the results will take place between June and July 2017.
- 18. Submitting the application to the Competition is equivalent to the acceptance of these Regulations.
- 19. Any disputes shall be settled in accordance with the Polish version of the Regulations.
